***TERROIR***

Vineyards are planted on mineral rich chalky-clay soils. The Mediterranean climate is influenced by the Atlantic Sea which provides a significant diurnal daily temperature range. South-facing slopes provide ideal exposure and drainage resulting in wines that are naturally balanced with concentrated flavours that age well over long periods.

***GRAPES***

Syrah, Aragonez and Touriga Nacional.

***VINIFICATION***

Grapes cooled to 12°C, fermented in small inox batches, with extended maceration on skins post ferment.

***BOTTLING***

October of 2011

***TASTING NOTES***

Ruby color, elegant aromas of ripe black fruits, vanilla and some complexity. Well structured with elegant and well integrated tannins to provide good balance and long-lived aftertaste.
